1	<b>Opening remarks</b>	Mr. D.P.Guleria, Director LSSC welcomed all the Principals and congratulated all members for their unstinted support in running all LSSC events seamlessly. He also thanked Mr. A. P. Sharma, Principal of the host school for volunteering to host this special session.
2.	<b>Confirmation of points of the previous meeting and 'Action taken' report:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Director reviewed the progress made by the core committee and the sub committees constituted in the last meeting.</li><li>• The Core committee members were appreciated for the draft bye-laws and requested to finalize it by the end of December.</li><li>• The sub-committees in sports and co-curricular were also requested to finalize the guidelines by the end of December and share the draft with the office bearers.</li></ul>

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4.	<b>Implementation and implications of NEP</b>	<p><b>Implementation and implications of NEP were discussed at length.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mrs. Jaswinder Kaur suggested subject wise common collaborative meetings for the teachers of the member schools. She informed that she has the master trainers and that if required, their services may be availed for the same.</li> </ul>																																		

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Such Common meetings for teachers will be twice a year</li> <li>• Mr.A.P.Sharma also volunteered to conduct an online session for the foundational stage teachers as per NEP</li> <li>• Mr. A. P. Sharma informed the members that CBSE is going to introduce a new system to track students' attendance in schools.</li> <li>• He further shared that this year CBSE will depute observers for practical examination. So, member schools must complete all the practicals as per CBSE guidelines.</li> </ul>
5.	<b>Core Committee</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In case of sudden declaration for school closure on account of <i>Band call</i> or any other matter, the core committee in consultation with office bearers will take a unanimous decision which shall be binding on all.</li> </ul>
6.	<b>Discussion and Unanimous Decisions Taken:</b>	<p>A discussion was held on varied issues and the following decisions were taken unanimously :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In order to ensure maximum participation, different /uncommon players should be involved in U-17 and U-19 categories in sports.</li> <li>• LSSC will provide only 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes to the member schools. Consolation prizes, if any, are to be arranged by the host school.</li> <li>• To organize any event, minimum number of participating schools should be seven</li> <li>• Guidelines of SGFI as uploaded on LSSC website should be strictly followed for framing guidelines for all sports events.</li> <li>• Member schools will have a common calendar for winter and summer vacation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Summer Vacation-6 weeks starting from the first day of June</li> <li>*Winter vacation- 10 days starting from the last day of December</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Member schools decided that the admission process for Nursery will start from the month of November and criteria of admission will be as per NEP (3years)</li> <li>• Menace of tuition was discussed at length. To curb this menace, it was unanimously decided that students must attend school 5 hours daily.</li> </ul>

7.	<b>Other points with the permission of the Chair:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mr D.P.Guleria shared that CBSE has formed a core committee to coordinate with different Sahodayas in the country. It has suggested that the schools within the radius of 20 km should create their Sahodaya and other schools outside this radius should form a new or join any other Sahodaya nearest to them.</li> <li>• He shared his concern over the nonparticipation and inactiveness of a few schools and advised them to participate unreservedly in all matters of LSSC.</li> <li>• He advised the host schools to show unbiased and genuine consideration for the requests of late entries /late arrival of teams on the campus.</li> <li>• He also requested to all Principals to attend the LSSC meetings in person and avoid sending their representatives.</li> </ul>
8.	<b>Vote of Thanks:</b>	<p>Ms Jaswinder Kaur Sidhu proposed the vote of thanks. She appreciated the support and cooperation from the Director. She thanked the host school for their impeccable hospitality and setting for the meeting. She also thanked all Principals for sparing time for the meeting and their active participation in discussions.</p>
